The Northern Pima County Chamber of Commerce Board of Directors endorses the passage of the Local Alternative Expenditure Limitation Option, commonly known as "Home Rule."

On March 9, voters in Oro Valley will be asked to support or not support "Home Rule," If "supported" the Town of Oro Valley will continue to set its own budget limits locally based upon community needs. If not "supported," the State of Arizona would impose budget limits based upon a fiscal year 1979-80 formula, thus reducing the Town budget by approximately \$74 million.

For your clarification, support of Home Rule does not allow for new taxes, nor does it allow the Town to otherwise spend more money than it receives from revenues generated.
